



Legal requirements: key principles

	Concise, transparent, intelligible, easily accessible Clear and plain language	Free, specific, informed and unambiguous

AUSTRIA

22 December 2021: DSB says Google Analytics is illegal.

FRANCE

31 December 2021: the CNIL fines Google EUR 150.000.000 in total and Facebook EUR 60.000.000 because users can't refuse cookies as easily as to accept them.


LUXEMBOURG

In 2021, the CNPD imposed **fines on 16 companies**, focussing on DPO and video-surveillance notably.
